- 1 stretched canvas or canvas panel per session, $11 \times 14$ or smaller. I will use a $8 \times 10$ " for my demo
- 2-3 various sizes oil paintbrushes: flats or brights (see picture below), size 6 and up, please include a wide flat brush, at least 1.5 inches wide (hardware store brushes are okay)
- Oil paints, can be any brand. Bring whatever paints you already have. If you a new at this, know that Primary colors are a must (Red, Yellow, Blue) plus White. Add a dark brown and a dark blue. Have fun when shopping for oil paints! You may add any highly saturated colors that look fun to you - I adore adding a teal and lavender color or a hot pink.
- Odorless mineral spirits
- Oil painting medium
- Palette knife
- Roll of Viva paper towels
- Small plastic bag (grocery bag is great)
- Palette (a flat palette - you may use a dollar store glass frame with a gray paper inserted in, tapped on all sides)
- Pharmaceutical gloves (get them at the drug store)
- Painter's apron
- Tape (any kind)
